The OR7 operating order is - GW, LPS, CPR, CA, GT - unless changed by SR5.

Just OR3 as a pause was requested before SR4. It is always good if, when possible, requests for pauses are made early and explicitly.

Next time - I am asking for OR4 but we will stop after SR4 if any company changes hands or if a new company is floated.
