At the same time, Steve reported that his program had been updated and had now found 3 points solutions for 3, 4 & 27. When faced with this knowledge Ian went back to work and also found those 3 point solutions for 3, 4 & 27. He said "... I laughed when I worked out the answer for 3". The answers for 3 & 4 were indeed alarmingly obvious with the gift of hindsight.

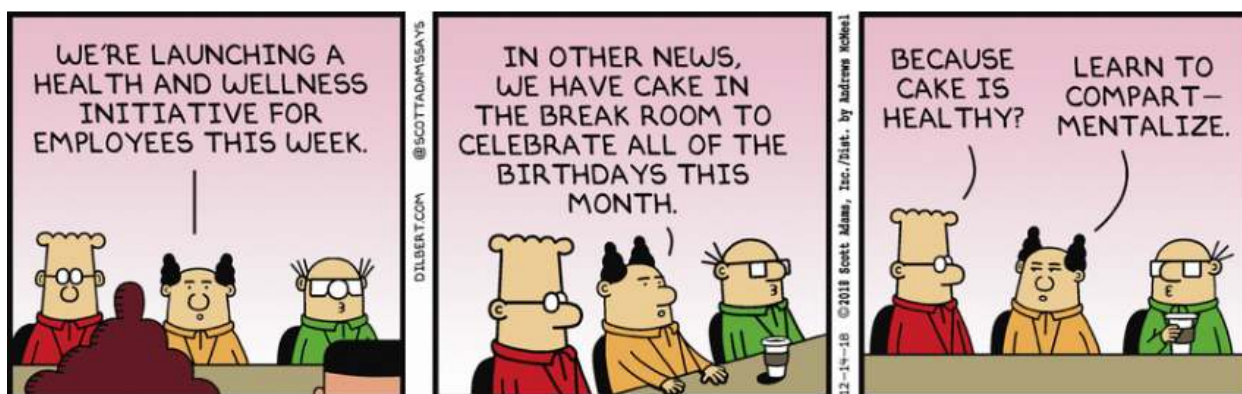
$$3 = ((8 - 8) * 3) + 3$$

$$4 = 8 / (8 - 3 - 3)$$

$$27 = (3 + (3 / 8)) \times 8$$

This gives a total score of 82 for the target numbers 1-30 as opposed to the advised maximum score of 79. So well done us. Or rather, well done to Mick, Steve & Ian.
