So hats off to whoever won - particularly if it was me. I guess if it wasn't, it will have been John so congratulations or commiserations to him and everyone else, as appropriate. Either way, I imagine it will have been close. I like this map now a lot more than I thought I would when it was chosen. Notwithstanding the requirement for three to start in London, it seems to be quite well balanced and presents some interesting challenges.

Plan A was to build a London to Lowestoft spine, and a brief negotiation with my London colleagues ensured I was one of two taking the direct London - Colchester route. Foolishly, I allowed myself to be seduced by the attraction of nipping up the valley to Bury St Edmunds and Thetford in round two, but Tony did the same - and did it more convincingly than me. I also expected Mike or John to prevail and had overlooked how good this last round could be (and was) for Tony. In the round Brad suffered from having to go via the east coast when running north to south or viceversa. David's network maybe suffered from overlap with John's. Although Tony & Mike's networks shared quite a lot they were distinct outside of that commonality. Mind you, David's network looks quite like the one I built in a game on this map which I won. Everything is conditional on what the other players do and which runs come up. He said wisely but without any meaningful addition to the fund of human knowledge.
