It stops in mid-sentence, presumably because it reached a limit of what you can get for free from ChatGPT.

On a recent Zoom call we used its AI Companion to generate a summary of our session along with action points. The result provided was plausible but inaccurate. The action points generated were definite, and were relevant to our discussion, but were not correct. The summary of the discussion played a lot back to us without being specific. It was okay as an aide memoire - but not as a record of the meeting. That seems to be a typical characteristic (he says with limited experience) of AI generated texts/documents - they bristle with relevant terms and phrases and can be persuasive without being definitive.
