Let me know if you need contact details.

Stephen also offered St. Petersburg in his last issue. I'll see how that works and dependent on how well it goes and how much space it takes may well offer it here as a nice diversion alongside the other games. If you know and like the game but don't know the computer program then give it a go – it plays well and a decent percentage win record against it on Expert Mode with 3 competitors seems to be in the low 30s. I'm actually in the low 40s at present but sinking with every group of games I play – not sure if it learns or whether I'm just averaging out to my correct level over a greater number of games. Or I could be better at it than Mike R and John W who have those low 30s ratings. Mind you – I know John has played over a 1,000 games so maybe I'm just thinking about each game a little more.
