I've also sat there and wondered why on earth some particular tracks were played - denying that I would have ever such an association. All in all a good diversion.

There were a number of errors in the last adjudication. The station on M10 was shown as having a value of 10 and not the correct 20. The MP did not receive credit for its redeemed shares, so end credit was 605 (the company's 50% is rounded up in 1870) and Jeff got 30 less cash and David 5 less. The TP run was 300 not 310 so its end credit was 404. The SSW & MKT Connection Runs did not use both of their trains and were really 400 and 320, giving end OR10 credit of 401 and 759, respectively. Sorry about all of that! And you'd better check this adjudication, which seems okay to me right now ... but time will tell. But I reckon that this time we slip right through the 6 and 8 trains and get the first 10 train into service ...
