GM A well-engineered win by Lyndon with income from 26 certificates at the end. Apart from the SLSF, managing the high value MP and the contributing SLSF & TP gave the victory. John had a by no means meagre 22 certificates and although Roger recovered very well - I'm not fantastically familiar with 1870 but two 12 trains in one company seems like an achievement, probably an over-achievement - there was no immediate danger of him overtaking John.
