This issue turned around early for Christmas - next orders please by 24 December. Before then I have a flurry of gigs and will see The Blockheads, Squeeze and The Lightning Seeds, The Pretty Things (at the sadly very likely to be soon defunct 100 Club) and Ian McNabb (and band) in a rabble rousing home town performance of Head Like A Rock. There will also be games - I recently bought Porto Carthago on the strength of a game with Markus Welbourne who taught us a set of rules that bore some similarity to the correct ones. I have played again with the right rules and it was good - and could get better with more familiarity (if you understand my meaning). I definitely rate K2 - shown to me by Mike R & Neil W - it plays well and in under an hour. We did also play 1880 (my first ftf 18xx for many years) which took more like 6 hours. Not so sure about that game - I won but did not feel that I consciously arranged to achieve the key factors that enabled the victory. Of course, it needs to be played more to understand how good it is - and I doubt that I will ever find the time. But reports about it on the 18xx Yahoo Group are more encouraging.
