This is an Average Card game. This reduces a luck factor by giving production cards in average values only. To increase the flexibility for spending - you actually get two 'half' cards of unequal value. For example, an Ore Factory has an average production value of three, so - for each Ore Factory - you get one value '1' card and one value '2' card.

Thus, every player starts with {o:1,1,1,1,2,2,2,2} & {w:3,3,4,4}.
