In the course of running the races I noticed that in round 1 I charged MIKER 5 to build the Newport News-Norfolk ferry instead of the correct 6. Consequently, one point has been deducted from MIKER's starting score for this round. It doesn't say so on the map, but there is +1 movement cost to embark to, and disembark from, a ferry. So, for example, it takes 3 movement to get from Newport News to Norfolk.

As most of you will recall, the number in [] after a company's name in the race report is the length of the run. If there were multiple start and/or end points for the race then the one used is named. If you are able to supply that information when ordering your runs then it means that I can cross-check my calculations and overall it reduces the chance of errors.

Runs 1 & 3 were closely contested and the finishing order in each case was as per route length (shortest won and so forth). GITCO & GRASS were equally lengthed for run 4 and crossed the line on the same turn - but GRASS went a vital single hex "further past the post". WEBBS entered the fray for run 5 and took first place with aplomb but was just edged out by SHE in run 6 - although their net earnings were similar.
