It is rather impressive to get three solid entrants for Washington to New Orleans. The lead went back and forth but in the end the finishing order matched the ascending route length. MIKER sorted out an ERP with WEBBS for run 37 and was rewarded with a win over equal length routes; GRASS tried a solo entry but had too far to go. SHE overcame a 12.5% deficit vs GITCO to take run 38 but GITCO was nowhere near overcoming a similar % deficit vs GRASS in run 39. GITCO held firm to finish just ahead of SHE in run 40, then SHE was an easy winner in run 41 but MIKER got 10 points for taking part. MIKER paid large to enter run 42 but in the absence of GRASS he benefitted more than expected. GRITS wanted to enter but his route included a reversal of direction which (as he suspected) ruled him out. MIKER was unable to make a desired entry earlier in the game for the same reason.

Surely a 54 point lead is enough for victory - even with limited opportunities this time. If it was - hurrah - and I never doubted my inevitable victory from turn one. If it wasn't, then congratulations to David, who I imagine is the only one who could catch me. Either way, I do like the Dixie map which requires a change in thinking from the traditional "Big-X" in the middle of the map - though I'm not entirely convinced of its balance without a bit of GM-intervention to force an even spread of starting locations. Had I had any serious competition in the North-East I certainly wouldn't have done so well, but the concentration of the opposition in the South West gave me a massive advantage, and I was able to build most of what I planned to cover the 1s, 2s, 3s and 6s virtually without competition. Lucky me.

Luck is always involved in RR ... more so in this map than some ... but Mike worked for his luck and it paid off. Mike's orders were always the most helpful and that again is a clue to his success. A special thank you to Stephen who tried RR for the first time and I suspect is unlikely to try it again - I think the problem was that he was looking for greater depth and was foxed by the simplicity of the game's surface. Or summat.

An RR game takes more time to adjudicate than an 18xx game ... but even so there is a list open a for a new game.
