So I sped up the trains to get a 2+2 in the K-M in preparation of losing the ByE. After I started the WtE, I can only assume that John W decided I wasn't losing badly enough. That is the only explanation I can come up with for the somewhat nonsensical tile lay at N10 by the ByE which prevented the WtE from having a run in its second OR (I, of course, share some blame for that since I should have allowed for the possibility in my orders.). In the end, the two spaces of share appreciation that it cost me would have been enough to get me third place instead of fourth (fourth sounds so much better than last).
