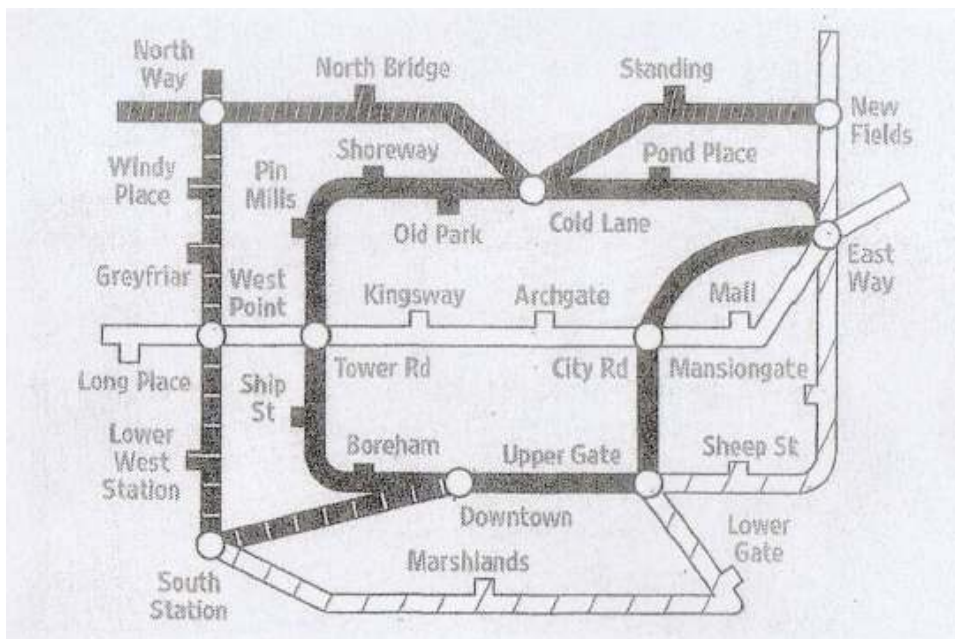


The 18xx games are on page 2 onwards in the order of starting. Outpost M16 is on p10, St. Petersburg M5 is on p11 and The Games That You Play is on p12.

New Games: None this time.

Last issue's minor diversion drew a few answers. Stephen, Ian & John S identified East Way as the station that the four agents - starting in North Way, New Fields, South Station & Lower Gate - could reach in 4 moves. Stephen & Ian also named Archgate as a mutual 7 stop destination. Ian also identified West Point as a mutual 7 stopper.



For the East Way & Archgate answers my two “insights” were that the North Way & New Fields starters could both reach Cold Lane in 2 stops and that City Rd and East Way had both a 1 stop connection and a 2 stop connection between them. Ian went beyond that with his West Point answer.

Okay, here's another typical challenge to fill the remaining space. Using all of and only the numbers 3, 3, 8, 8 and the addition, subtraction, multiplication, division operations we can get to 9 and 10 as follows ...

- > $9 = (3 \times 3) + (8 - 8)$
- > $10 = (3 \times 3) + 8/8$

Can you find a way of getting 24?

If you want to go nuts on this then - can you get all of the numbers from 1 to 30 using all of and only the numbers 3, 3, 8, 8?

If you use only the addition, subtraction, multiplication and division operations then score 3 points for the target number. If you also use $\sqrt[3]{8}$ (cube root of 8 - counting as using one 3 and one 8) and/or 3^3 (cube of 3 - counting as using 3 twice) then score 2 points for the target. If you also use $3!$ (factorial 3 - counting as using 3 once) then score 1 point for the number. The answers I give next time score 79 points.

That reliable source of confusion - the PfA special power - rears its head again. The power can be exercised by the owner of the PfA if he is also the director of a share company. But only (I have decided following research) when acting as the director of a share company. So Tony B could lay on L6 during the turn of the SxE but not during the turn of the B-M. As the tile on L6 is laid the BaE home base token (which had been invoked by the flotation of the BaE in the previous dealing round) must be placed (without needing the PfA special power). As it happens, the end result matches Tony B's intentions. The question not tested here is whether the director of share company can use the PfA special power to place a base of a different company on L6.

Such fun.
