

The 18xx games are in order of starting from p2 - except that 1856W41 is missing (see below). RR2362EA is on p8, St. Petersburg M5 is on p9 and Outpost M16 is on p10. The Games That You Play is below.

New Games: None - none of the waiting lists are full enough for a new game.

1856M41 has ended following a proposal by Ian who posited that the current player order would also be the final player order. All players accepted this proposal and thus the game ends with Graham Lee as the winner followed by Tony Sait, Ian Pendlebury, John Webley & George Lucas. Any comments received will be printed next time.

1856W41 is held over in the full expectation of running next time with a full set of player orders. The orders that were received this time (from all but Ian P plus Graham L - away on an extended foreign jaunt) will be used if not replaced.

Meanwhile, over at the web site, this was the first issue to include Outpost & Saint Petersburg results alongside the 18xx and RR results. The new reports are pdf files embedded in their respective web pages and the appearance/presentation of the reports varies from browser to browser and device to device (or maybe that should be - varies more than other aspects). If you notice anything particularly untoward or annoying about the Outpost and Saint Petersburg additions then please let me know.

The Saint Petersburg will finish next time and I should consider what will replace it. Traditionally it would be another Saint Petersburg (SP) or In The Year Of The Dragon (ITYOTD). But maybe it should be something else. If you have a yen for a game of SP or ITYOTD then let me know for next time. Suggestions for other games are welcome but whether they get taken up will depend on how well and how long they would play in the Minstrel style and also how easily I think I could handle them and, probably more importantly, present the results.

The building allowance for each of rounds 1-6 will be derived from three die rolls in the range 3 to 6 with no one round ever having more than one roll of 3. The building allowance in round 7 will be 12 points (plus payments to rivals) and will then decrease by 2 for each subsequent round.

We're back with just two auctions, one uncontested. The two replacements did include a Planetary Cruiser but not include a Moon Base.
