New Games: I imagine no waiting list action until the new year ...

Okay, time to wonder what to write. I am fully caught up in the cliché of “how did I ever find time to work”. I do have some (unpaid) responsibilities but probably my single biggest activity is “dicking around”. So easy to do with the internet, and a host of mobile apps, at my fingertips.

Then there’s the weekly band session with the need to practice beforehand. We used to meet up to play about once a month until lockdown drove us to find a virtual solution - and we started playing remotely using a program called Jamulus. There is the expected slight delay between creating a note/beat and hearing it (we all listen to the feed from the central server) but our brains managed to adapt in quite short order. Every now and then one of our connections will be hit by too much delay but it works well pretty much all the time. We play for about two hours (so roughly the same amount of playing time per month as when we used to meet up) but the frequency has meant that we have all improved. We have still met up in person but less so as the host of the physical location did deteriorate during the pandemic. Another advantage of the Jamulus solution is that recordings can be easily made available with all tracks aligned (to cater for our differing arrival times in the session). Those recordings also help us to improve (and we are past wringing our hands at our bloopers).

But nothing beats meeting up in person and playing together - be it focused around music and/or games ...
