**Building Allowances** The round 10 building allowance is but 6 points (including known payments to rivals) and the allowance will then decrease by 2 for each subsequent round.

Phase 3 is achieved after a round with some interacting conditional orders - so it is worth checking that what happened accords with your orders ...
