An exchange with Dane told me that I have never explained the Limits value given for robots. I will do that now whilst I remember. The number shown is how many robots the relevant player can currently assign - not how many they can buy. A player can buy robots above the presented limit but could not use them until they had either bought more colonists and/or they had bought a(nother) Robots card.

Meanwhile we are apparently nearing the end of this game. David has the most VPs at present but is predicted to have a lower production than Mick who is 3VPs behind him.
